



~Candy Sack~

Size 5" X 8"

This cute little sack is a great gift for teachers, co-worker or someone special. I made these sack's for my children's teachers. Then I filled them with creamy caramels. They were a big hit!

What you need~ (Enough to make 2 sacks)

1 fat 1/4 for outside of sack.

1 fat 1/4 for lining of sack.

18 inches of ribbon. (36" to make 2 sacks)

Cutting~

Outside of sack~

*Cut (1) 6 1/2" X 10 1/2" rectangle.

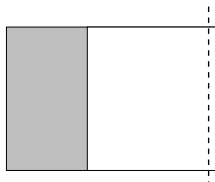
Lining of sack~

*Cut (1) 10 1/2" X 10 1/2" rectangle.

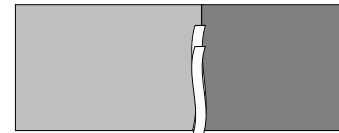
Let's Begin~

*With right sides together, layer the 10 1/2" sides of the outside and lining of sack.

*Stitch along 10 1/2" side. Press.

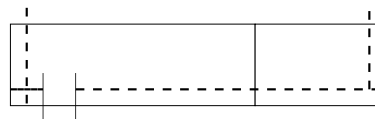


*Fold ribbon in half and pin folded side to right side of sack where the lining and outside are stitched together.



*Fold sack in half the long way, right sides together.

*Stitch around sack, leaving a 2" opening on the lining side of the sack.

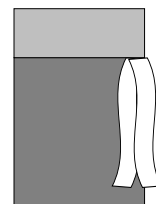


*Turn sack right side out.

*Stitch opening, closed.

*Fold lining, into sack, leaving 2" of lining at the top of the sack.

*Fill sack with creamy caramels and give it to your favorite someone!
